



**Meet Jennifer S. Maddox, President & CEO.** Jennifer joined the staff in September of 2011 as their second president and CEO.

Previously she held a unique position in Plymouth, Indiana—serving as the CEO of two not-for-profit organizations: the Marshall County Community Foundation and the United Way of Marshall County. As the CEO she was responsible for all aspects of management for both organizations including: Administration, Development, Fund Raising, Personnel, Volunteers, Public Relations, Publications, Financial Reporting, Budgeting, Technology, Programs and Services, etc. Community Foundation assets under management were approximately \$25 million and the 2010 United Way annual campaign raised \$460,000.

Prior to that position Jennifer served as Manager of Administration & Finance for the Department of Physics at the University of Notre Dame for eight years from June 1998 to May 2006. Before joining the University she served as the Executive Director of the Mental Health Association of St. Joseph County, Inc. (a United Way agency).

Jennifer received her Bachelor of Business Administration degree in Finance from the University of Houston in 1993. She earned her Master of Business Administration from the University of Notre Dame in 2005.

In addition to her professional and educational experience, Ms. Maddox has also taught at Brown Mackie College as an Adjunct Faculty member and she is also a Certified Motorcycle Safety Instructor with the Indiana Department of Education, teaching motorcycle safety from 1999 to the present.
